ENGINEERING INSURANCE - INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

Conceptual Background: Engineering insurance has traditionally been moderate premium producing portfolio for Property insurers. Consequent to privatisation stiff competition among the insurers and caused considerable concerns among the underwriters about their projections on income and profitability of the portfolio. Decision making on risk analysis, acceptance and pricing of risks has now assumed greater importance.

The need of the hour, therefore, is to effectively acquire and employ appropriate risk management and prudent claim assessment skills to manage this class of business better. Realizing this need, Insurance Institute of India has developed a specific course to deal with critical issues in risk analysis, loss prevention and control; and claims management relating to the Engg portfolio to suit the surveyors .

Program Objectives: In concrete terms, the program seeks to help claims professionals and surveyors achieve the following:

- 1. Understanding the processes involved in managing Engg risks
- 2. Appreciating the roles and functions of an underwriter, risk engineer, loss assessor,
- 3. Updating and enhancing the understanding of different insurance policies in the Engg department,
- 4. Deliberating on details pertaining to CAR EAR insurance,
- 5. Familiarization with the concepts of "All Risks" insurance,
- 6. Developing a deeper understanding of pre-acceptance and post-loss survey, with the help of examples.
- 7. Understanding the important steps in claim management process,
- 8. Knowledge sharing with interactive sessions.

Course Content: The 3 day course would cover various topics related to Engg claims settlement. It will discuss in detail policies like MBD, CAR, EAR, MCE, Boiler, EEI, Mlop and issues and challenges in claims settlement.

Participant Profile: The programme is specially designed for people involved in doing loss assessment prior to accepting the risk and people dealing with property claims whose roles and contributions would require developing and updating specific knowledge and skills on all aspects related to Engg insurance portfolio
